

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA NOV. 30.1983

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. The following lands are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve until September 1, 1984:

a) Skeena Mining Division; Queen Charlotte Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 45, Port Chanal:

Commencing at the most southerly point on the natural boundary of Skelu Point on Graham Island; thence northwesterly, northerly, easterly, westerly, and northerly along the natural boundary of Graham Island to the most westerly point on the natural boundary of Selvesen Point; thence south 21 degrees west, a distance of 3 000 m; thence due south a distance of 3 200 m; thence south 45 degrees east to a point due west of the most southerly point on the natural boundary of Skelu Point on Graham Island; thence due east to the most southerly point on the natural boundary of Skelu Point on Graham Island, being the point of commencement.

b) Victoria Mining Division; Victoria Land District; Extension to Ecological Reserve 94, Griffin Island:

The area within District Lot 155, Victoria Land District, known as Griffin Island.

c) Nanaimo Mining Division; Rupert Land District, Ecological Reserve Proposal 111.5:

Commencing at the natural boundary of the confluence of Tsitika River and Russell Creek, on the right bank of Russell Creek; thence easterly upstream along the natural boundary of the right bank of Russell Creek to the point of intersection of said creek with the 900 foot contour line; thence due south to the point of intersection with the 1 000 foot contour line; thence westerly and southerly along the 1 000 foot contour line to the point of intersection with the natural boundary of the tributary of Aldworth Creek, on the right bank thereof;

thence south 45 degrees west to the natural boundary of Aldworth Creek on the right bank thereof; thence northwesterly along the natural boundary of Aldworth Creek on the right bank thereof, to the natural boundary of the confluence with the Tsitika River, on the right bank thereof; thence northerly along the natural boundary of Tsitika River, on the right bank thereof to the natural boundary of the confluence of Tsitika River and Russell Creek, on the right bank of Russell Creek, being the point of commencement.

c) Nainimo Mining Division; Rupert Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 111.3, Mt. Derby:

Commencing on the natural boundary of the confluence of Catherine Creek and Tsitika River on the left bank thereof; thence due south a distance of 150 m; thence due east a distance of 2 700 m; thence due north a distance of 3 200 m; thence due west to the natural boundary of Tsitika River on the left bank thereof; thence southerly along the natural boundary of Tsitika River on the left bank thereof to the natural boundary of the confluence of Catherine Creek and Tsitika River on the left bank thereof, being the point of commencement.

c) Nainimo Mining Division; Rupert Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 111.2, Mudge Lake:

Commencing on the natural boundary of the confluence of Catherine Creek and Tsitika River on the left bank thereof; thence due west 5 600 m; thence due north 3 000 m; thence due east to the natural boundary of Tsitika River on the left bank thereof; thence southerly along the natural boundary of Tsitika River on the left bank thereof to the natural boundary of the confluence of Catherine Creek and Tsitika River on the left bank thereof, being the point of commencement.

d) Cariboo Mining Division; Cariboo Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 211, Mandalay Creek:

District Lots 2288, 2298, 4194, 4195, 4196, 4291, 6279, 6280, 6281, and 6282 all within Cariboo Land District.

e) Cariboo Mining Division; Cariboo Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 214, Slim Creek:

Commencing at the northwest corner of District Lot 5491, Cariboo Land District; thence due east 3 500 m; thence due south 5 000 m; thence due west 3 500 m; thence northerly to the northwest corner of District Lot 5491, Cariboo Land District, being the point of commencement.

f) Vancouver Mining Division; Coast Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 271:

All those parcels or tracts of land known as the Storm Islands and the Naiad and Reid Islets, situated within the Queen Charlotte Strait, Range 2, Coast Land District; also the Tree Islets, the Buckle Group, and Pine Island, situated within the Queen Charlotte Strait, Range 1, Coast Land District.

✓ g) Omineca Mining Division; Coast Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 299, Ellis Island:

Lot 6376, Township 15, Range 5, Coast Land District, known as Ellis Island.

✓ h) Fort Steele Mining Division; Kootenay Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 302, Dewar Creek:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the 5100 foot contour with the natural boundary of Dewar Creek on the right bank thereof; thence due east 150 m; thence due south 450m; thence due west 350m; thence due north 450m; thence westerly 200 m more or less to the 5100 foot contour with the natural boundary of Dewar Creek on the right bank thereof, being the point of commencement.

✓ i) Kamloops Mining Division; Kamloops Division of Yale Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 317, Hellroar Creek:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the natural boundary of north Thompson River on the left bank thereof, with the northerly boundary of Lot 2494 Kamloops Division of Yale Land District; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Lot 2494 to the northeast corner thereof; thence 300 m easterly along the prolongation of the northerly boundary of said Lot 2494; thence northeasterly to the southwest corner of Lot 2497 Kamloops Division of Yale Land District; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Lot 2497 to the intersection with the natural boundary of North Thompson River on the left bank thereof; thence southwesterly along the natural boundary of North Thompson River on the left bank thereof to the point of intersection of the natural boundary of North Thompson River on the left bank thereof, with the northerly boundary of Lot 2494 Kamloops Division of Yale Land District, being the point of commencement.

✓ j) Cariboo Mining Division; Lillooet Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 325, Rock Lake:

Area Number 1

Commencing at the point 100 m due west of the northeast corner of Section 26, Township 50, in the Lillooet Land District; thence due east 500 m; thence due south 500 m; thence due west 500 m; thence northerly to the point 100 m due west of the northeast corner of Section 26, Township 50, in the Lillooet Land District, being the point of commencement.

Area Number 2

Commencing at the point 150 m due north and 800 m due east of the northeast corner of Section 26, Township 50, in the Lillooet Land District; thence due east 275 m; thence due south 300 m; thence due west 275 m; thence northerly to the point 150 m due north and 800 m due east of the northeast corner of Section 26, Township 50, in the Lillooet Land District, being the point of commencement.

✓ k) Nainaimo Mining Division; Rupert Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 327, Stubbs Island:

Area Number 1

Commencing at the point of intersection of the parallel of Latitude 50 degrees 37 minutes north with the meridian of longitude 126 degrees 47 minutes 45 seconds west; thence south 67 degrees west to the point of intersection with the meridian of longitude 126 degrees 50 minutes west; thence south 30 degrees east to the point of intersection with the parallel of latitude 50 degrees 35 minutes north; thence north 47 degrees east a distance of 3 000 m; thence northwesterly to the point of intersection of the parallel of latitude 50 degrees 37 minutes north with the meridian of longitude 126 degrees 37 minutes 45 seconds west, being the point of commencement.


Area Number 2

Commencing at a point 550 m due south of the point of intersection of the parallel of latitude 50 degrees 34 minutes 30 seconds north with the meridian of longitude 126 degrees 50 minutes west; thence south 82 degrees east a distance of 2 500 m; thence due north a distance of 350 m; thence north 58 degrees 30 minutes west a distance of 2 200 m; thence southwesterly to a point 550 m due south of point of intersection of the parallel of latitude 50 degrees 34 minutes 30 seconds north with the meridian of longitude 126 degrees 50 minutes west, being the point of commencement.

✓ 1) Victoria Mining Division; Cowichan Land District; Ecological Reserve Proposal 329, Galiano Island:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 84, Cowichan Land District; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Lot 84, to the northeast corner thereof; thence southerly along easterly boundary of said Lot 84, a distance of 800 m; thence due west to the intersection with the westerly boundary of the afore mentioned Lot 84; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Lot 84 to its northwest corner, being the point of commencement.

2. No free miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
