BC Prosecution Service approves charges against Langley RCMP Officer

Victoria – The BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) announced today that a charge of breach of trust has been approved against Langley RCMP Cst. Navarash Dhillon in connection with their involvement in incidents that allegedly occurred in Langley between September 10, 2018, and December 29, 2018.

An Information charging Cst. Dhillon with one count of breach of trust contrary to section 122 of the *Criminal Code* was sworn on June 1, 2023, under Provincial Court file number 253102-1. The first appearance on this matter is scheduled for June 22, 2023, in Surrey Provincial Court.

The charges were approved by an experienced Crown Counsel with no prior or current connection with the officer. The charge assessment guidelines applied by the BCPS in reviewing all Reports to Crown Counsel are established in the BCPS Crown Counsel Policy Manual and are available online at:
