(2) upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in the right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall locate upon and no free miner shall stake on such lands.

(3) with respect to the Placer Mining Act the lands described above are hereby designated as placer reserves.
