CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF CECIL EDWARD McKENNA

VANCOUVER— The inquest into the death of Cecil Edward McKenna has been scheduled. On Oct. 27, 2007, Mr. McKenna was detained by police and transported to the Surrey RCMP detachment. He was later discovered unresponsive in cells. The death was confirmed by emergency medical services at the scene.

The inquest is scheduled for Nov. 19-21, 2008. Presiding coroner Tonia Grace and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
