British Columbia export values are down -14% for June 2019 year to date (YTD) compared to the same period in 2018 (\$6.5 billion vs \$7.6 billion)

- Lumber export Value is down -20% while volumes are down -6%. The value of Other Wood Products is down -7% while log exports YTD are also down (-9%).
- Pulp and paper export Pulp value is down -13% while the value of paper products is up (+2%).
- Value by destination United States (-18%), China (-6%), Japan (-15%) and other countries (-14%) are all down in June 2019 YTD.

- Quantities exported to China (Table 10) June 2019 YTD saw an +18% increase in softwood lumber and an +8% increase in pulp quantity exports to China.
- Softwood Lumber Product Share (Table 8) The share of softwood lumber in export product values is 40% in June 2019 YTD. It was 43% in June 2018 YTD.
- Paper Export Value (Fig. 9) The value of paper exports remains higher than YTD values last year. It represents 8% of total export values (see Table 1) in June 2019 YTD which is up from 7% in June 2018 YTD.






Figure 6: Pulp Export Value -


Figure 8: Other Wood Export Value12 Month Moving Sum







Figure 17: Pulp Export Quantity




Figure 18: Pulp Export Quantity - 12 Month Moving Sum




Figure 19: Logs Export Quantity




Figure 20: Log Export Quantity - 12 Month Moving Sum
