Water Protection & Sustainability Branch Environmental Sustainability and Strategic Policy Division BC Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy The Water Protection and Sustainability Branch rescinds the 2002 B.C. approved chlorate water quality guidelines (WQGs) for the protection of drinking water supplies of 2.4 mg/L (B.C. Ministry of Environment, 2002a). The source drinking WQG value of 1 mg/L of chlorate (ENV, 2020) now applies to the Ambient Water Quality Guidelines for Chlorate Technical Background Report (B.C. Ministry of Environment, 2002a) and Overview Report (B.C. Ministry of Environment, 2002b).
