Summary

On October 26, 2023, F5 published security advisories to address vulnerabilities in multiple products. Included were updates for the following:

- BIG-IP multiple versions and modules
- BIG-IP Next version 20.0.1
- BIG-IP Next SPK version 1.5.0 to 1.8.2
- BIG-IP Next CNF version 1.1.0 to 1.1.1

Technical Details

This vulnerability may allow an unauthenticated attacker with network access to the BIG-IP system through the management port and/or self IP addresses to execute arbitrary system commands. There is no data plane exposure; this is a control plane issue only.

This vulnerability is rated as a **Critical** Severity.

Recommended Action

- Investigate how your area of responsibility is affected.
- Notify business owner(s) as required.
- Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.
