## **Criminal Justice Branch Releases Public Report on Riot Prosecutions**

The Criminal Justice Branch (the Branch), Ministry of Justice, today released a detailed report on the prosecutions resulting from the 2011 Stanley Cup Riot in Vancouver.

The scope of the Riot investigations and their related prosecutions was unprecedented in B.C. This report offers a unique, behind-the-scenes look at the evidentiary and procedural complexities that were faced by police and Crown Counsel in advancing these cases.

Consistent with the Branch's ongoing efforts to enhance public awareness of its role as a Prosecution Service, the report contains an overview of the prosecution process for the Riot cases, summarizes their outcomes, and provides important insight on the mechanics of prosecutions that were dependent on video and photographs as the foundation of the Crown's evidence.
