1. Upgrade of existing exterior light fixtures with high efficiency LED light fixtures at five (5) school locations, the Board Office and the Plant Service building.
2. Installation of local high efficiency radiant classroom heaters at Phoenix Elementary School, replacing a central electric furnace unit.
3. Installation of a high efficiency electric heating boiler at the Saturna Ecological Education Centre (SEEC).
Describe plans your organization has for continuing to minimize your GHG emissions:
Several upgrades to existing building mechanical systems will go forward in 2016 and, with planning and procurement already in place, a large solar photovoltaic panel installation at Pender Islands Elementary Secondary School will be completed by mid-April 2016 (the result of a partnership between School District No. 64 (Gulf Islands) and the Pender Islands Solar Group [PSI 2020]).


### **Retirement of Offsets:**
