### **CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF DANIEL ANTONY KING**

BURNABY – The inquest into the death of Daniel Antony King has now been scheduled. On Oct. 13, 2006, Mr. King was shot during an incident with New Westminster Police Service and Burnaby RCMP. He was transported to Royal Columbian Hospital, where despite medical treatment, he died.

The inquest is scheduled for Dec. 8-12 and 15-17, 2008. Presiding coroner Vince Stancato and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
