CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF LARRY McPHERSON

FORT ST. JOHN – The inquest into the death of Larry Lee McPherson has been scheduled. On Aug. 28, 2007, Mr. McPherson was in the custody of Fort St. John RCMP when he went into medical distress. Emergency medical services attended and transported him to Fort St. John General Hospital where, despite medical attention, he died.

The inquest is scheduled for Oct. 22-24, 2008. Presiding coroner Shane DeMeyer and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
