VICTORIA – The BC Coroners Service will hold a public inquest into the death of Hayden Blair Kozeletski. Ms. Kozeletski was a patient at Queen Alexandra Hospital. On Dec. 19, 2010, she returned to the facility after a weekend outing. Later that day, she was found deceased a short distance from the hospital.

Presiding coroner Matthew Brown and a jury will hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses to determine the facts surrounding this death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
