BURNABY – The BC Coroners Service has announced it will hold an inquest into the death of Mr. Jeffrey James Alvin Wright. Mr. Wright died after being shot by police at his residence in Langley on August 7, 2010.

The inquest is scheduled from Monday, March 26 until Friday, March 30, 2012.

Presiding coroner Vince Stancato and a jury will hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses to determine the facts surrounding this death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.

An inquest is a formal court process that allows for public presentation of evidence relating to a death. The British Columbia Coroners Service is an independent fact-finding agency that may not make any finding of legal responsibility.
