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Pursuant to Section 38 of the Coroners Act, the following recommendations are forwarded to the Chief Coroner of the Province of British Columbia for distribution to the appropriate agency:

JURY RECOMMENDATIONS:

To: BC Coroners Service and Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General

1. Additional resources be provided to the BC Coroners Service to conduct inquests more quickly, where possible.

To: RCMP E Division, the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General, and the Ministry of Health

2. Consider funding and deploying additional mental health liaison teams, such as Car 67 which currently operates in Langley, B.C., regionally.

To: RCMP E Division and Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General

3. Mandate the implementation of an Independent Officer Review after a police-involved incident where serious injury or death occurred.
