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Pursuant to Section 38 of the Coroners Act, the following recommendations are forwarded to the Chief Coroner of the Province of British Columbia for distribution to the appropriate agency:

JURY RECOMMENDATIONS:

To: Director of Policing and Law Enforcement Services, Ministry of Public Safety & Solicitor General

1. Review the Provincial Policing Standards to ensure standards and training require police to conduct ongoing risk assessments throughout mental health wellness checks, including where there are threats to public safety such as firearms.
2. Review the Provincial Policing Standards to ensure standards and training require police officers to be aware of the circumstances in which lethal overwatch is required when conducted energy weapons are used.
3. Review the Provincial Policing Standards to ensure standards and training consider the presence of civilians during wellness checks where there are elements of risk.
4. Review the Provincial Policing Standards to ensure standards and training for mental health outreach officers integrate standardized mental health training.
5. Review the Provincial Policing Standards to ensure officers involved in a matter investigated by the Independent Investigations Office (IIO) are aware of recommendations provided in the IIO's public report.
6. Review the Provincial Policing Standards to include the facilitation of meetings between law enforcement agency leadership and involved officers in order to discuss IIO recommendations and determine if further internal policies need to be developed and/or revised.

7. Identify supports for Indigenous individuals with intersectional barriers while navigating applications for housing.
