### **BC Coroners Service Announces Inquest into Death of Bradley Michael Thomas Haslam**

VERNON -- The BC Coroners Service has announced that a public inquest will be held into the death of Bradley Michael Thomas Haslam.

The inquest will take place from March 31 through April 4, 2014, at the Vernon Court Services.

Mr. Haslam, aged 18, of Lumby, died on June 15, 2013, as a result of a workplace incident at a Planer Mill in Lavington, BC.

Presiding coroner, Chico Newell, and a jury will hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses to determine the facts surrounding this death. While the jury may not, by law, make any findings of legal responsibility, it will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.

An inquest is a formal process that allows for public presentation of evidence relating to a death.
