There are specific requirements when family law cases are filed in these Registry locations of the Provincial Court of B.C.:

- » Port Coquitlam
- » Surrey
- » Victoria

These requirements are called **Early Resolution Registry requirements**.

The requirements apply to cases about:

- » Parenting arrangements
- » Child support
- » Contact with a child
- » Guardianship of a child
- » Spousal support
- » Property division in respect of a companion animal


