Starting May 13, 2019, the Provincial Court of BC and the Victoria Justice Access Centre will offer a new Early Resolution and Case Management process.

Is this for me?



Family law issues filed in the Victoria Registry of the Provincial Court of British Columbia will go through the Early Resolution and Case Management process. This will help with issues like:

- child support or spousal support
- parenting arrangements
- contact or guardianship

What will I do?



- Make an appointment and have your needs assessed by a qualified family justice counsellor and get information and referrals.
- Complete the Parenting After Separation program.
- Participate in at least one consensual dispute resolution (unless exempted) where you can try to resolve your issues and improve communication.
- If you go to court, you will start with a Family Management Conference.
