

# Important information about the BC Services Card when renewing your driver's licence or BCID

Now in BC when you renew your driver's licence or BCID you can also renew enrolment in the Medical Services Plan (MSP) and apply for a BC Services Card.

The new BC Services Card is part of government's plan to modernize BC's health care system. It replaces your CareCard, can be combined with your driver's licence and also acts as your photo ID. It's more convenient and more secure, with enhanced features to protect your personal information. For health care, you will use it the same way you use your CareCard today, there's no additional fee, and getting yours is easy. Just bring your CareCard with you when you visit your ICBC driver licensing office.

# Steps for renewing enrolment in MSP and applying for your new BC Services Card

1



Receive notice in the mail to renew your driver's licence or BCID, or renew/complete enrolment in Medical Services Plan (MSP).

2

Check your driver's licence and CareCard to be sure your name exactly matches on both. If not, call Health Insurance BC at 604.683.7151 or 1.800.663.7100.



3



Visit an ICBC driver licensing office with 2 pieces of ID. Bring your CareCard if you have it.

4

Confirm you are a BC resident and have your photo taken.

Receive your new BC Services Card in the mail.
