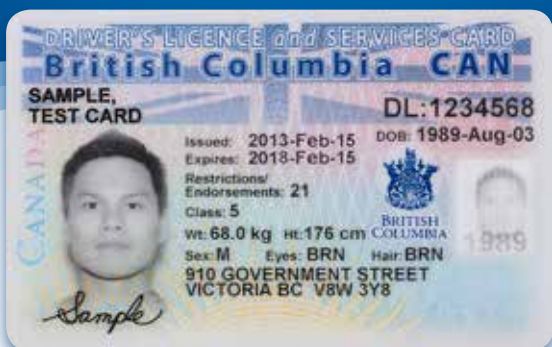


# It's time to get your BC Services Card



## A current BC Services Card:

- Replaces your CareCard when accessing health services.
- Ensures you have renewed your enrolment in the Medical Services Plan.
- Is valid government ID.
- Has security features that better protect your personal information.
- Can be combined with your driver's licence.
- Will allow future access to government services.

# Follow these steps to obtain a BC Services Card and renew your Medical Services Plan enrolment.

Make sure your name is an exact match on your driver's licence and BC Services Card (or CareCard if you still have one). If not, call Health Insurance BC at 604 683-7151 or 1 800 663-7100.

Visit an ICBC driver licensing office with 2 pieces of ID (visit [icbc.com](http://icbc.com) for accepted IDs). Also bring your expired BC Services Card and your CareCard.

At the ICBC driver licensing office, confirm you are a B.C. resident and have your photo taken.

Receive your BC Services Card in the mail.
