DIRECTIVE RESPECTING RECORDS AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC WITHOUT A REQUEST  
UNDER THE *FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT*

**DIRECTIVE:** 02-2020

**SUBJECT:** **Disclosure of Corporate Transition Binder Prepared for Incoming Premier**

**AUTHORITY:** This directive is issued under section 71.1 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.

**APPLICATION:** This directive applies to all ministries.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** December 15, 2020

## Minister of Citizens' Services

### Directive to all Ministries issued under section 71.1 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*

Under section 71.1 (1) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 165 (FOIPPA), I, Lisa Beare, Minister of Citizens' Services, establish the following as a category of records available to the public without a request under that Act:

#### **Corporate Transition Binder Prepared for Incoming Premier**

Under section 71.1 (4) and (5) of FOIPPA, the corporate transition binder must be disclosed in the manner and by the timelines set out below:

- (1) The binder must be redacted to remove any information that must be excepted from disclosure if the binder was requested under FOIPPA.
- (2) The binder may also be redacted to remove any information that may be excepted from disclosure if the binder was requested under FOIPPA.
- (3) The binder must be made available through the Open Information website within 90 calendar days of a new Cabinet being sworn in.
- (4) In order to meet the timelines specified in (3), ministries must meet the timelines for identifying harms and approving their final sections of the binder for disclosure, as communicated to them by Information Access Operations in the Corporate Information and Records Management Office of the Ministry of Citizens' Services.

This Directive is effective as of December 15, 2020.
