**DISMISSAL ORDER**

WHEREAS:

- A. On October 6, 2022, and October 11, 2022, respectively, the Appellant filed an appeal and filing fee under s. 20.3 of the *PCAA* with respect to the seizure of 1 cat.
- B. On October 20, 2022, the BCFIRB received a signed settlement agreement between the Appellant, Asheley Popp, and the Respondent, which permitted the Respondent to provide a copy of the agreement to the British Columbia Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB), with the effect of dismissing the appeal.
- C. Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, S.B.C. 2004, c. 45 provides that where the parties advise the tribunal that they have reached a settlement of all or part of an application, the tribunal must order the appeal or that part of the appeal be dismissed.

THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:

1. That this appeal is dismissed.
