DISMISSAL ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On February 1, 2018 the Complainant (Marinus Sommer) filed a complaint under Section 3 of the *Farm Practices Protection (Right to Farm) Act* (“*the FPPA*”) with respect to odour generated from a neighbouring medicinal marijuana grow operation.
- B. In a February 22, 2018 email, the complainant confirmed that he will be withdrawing his complaint.
- C. Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, S.B.C. 2004, c. 45 provides that where an Complainant has withdrawn all or part of a complaint the tribunal must order the complaint dismissed.
