DISMISSAL ORDER


WHEREAS:

- A. On November 22, 2021, the complainant, Brar Farms, filed a complaint under Section 3 of the *Farm Practices Protection (Right to Farm) Act* (“*the FPPA*”) with respect to dust generated from chicken vents from a neighbouring farm operation (Windermere Farms.).
- B. In a March 21, 2022 email, the complainant advised that the parties had reached a settlement and they were withdrawing their complaint.
- C. Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, S.B.C. 2004, c. 45 provides that where the complainant has withdrawn all or part of the complaint, the tribunal must order the complaint dismissed.

THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:

1. That the complaint filed by Iqbal Singh Brar (Brar Farms) is dismissed.
