ORDER

WHEREAS:

- On March 28, 2018 K&M Farms filed an appeal from the March 23, 2018 decision of the British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board to not direct Rosstown to continue processing services to K&M Farms.

- On June 29, 2018 K&M Farms withdrew their appeal;
- Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, SBC 2004, c. 45 provides if an appellant withdraws an appeal, the tribunal must order that the appeal is dismissed.

THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:

1. That the appeal filed by K&M Farms from the March 23, 2018 decision of the British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board to not direct Rosstown to continue processing services is dismissed without costs.
