**OPPORTUNITY TO REVIEW BC FARM INDUSTRY REVIEW BOARD 2005 QUOTA TRANSFER DIRECTIONS**

I am writing to alert you to the opportunity to assess, and if determined necessary, provide recommendations to the BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) on amendments to quota transfer directions arising out of the [2005 Specialty Review](#). BCFIRB has received industry-specific recommendations from the BC Milk Marketing Board, the BC Egg Marketing Board and the BC Chicken Marketing Board to amend certain quota transfer directions. BCFIRB board members have reviewed these requests and have decided to further consider the requests at their September 10-11, 2014 meeting along with any new information provided by your two boards.

In summary:

*BC Milk Marketing Board is recommending:*

- No change to 10/10/10 LIFO with extension of the quota transfer exemption list to include nieces, nephews and grandchildren. For more information, see the Milk Board [web site](#).

*BC Egg Marketing Board is recommending:*

- Amend 10/10/10 LIFO to 20/6/0 LIFO.
- Remove the 5% quota transfer assessment on quota issued previous to September 1, 2005. For more information see the Egg Board [web site](#).

*BC Chicken Marketing Board is recommending:*

- Amend the deemed quota transfer assessment to exempt quota transfers to direct family members; and, business restructuring involving a change from partnership to a corporation where the shareholders remain the same or a change in the percentage of ownership


