On May 6, 2016 FIRB forwarded to all participants an excerpt from the Board minutes relating to a proposal from Ontario to move its 700,000 kg of Kosher production into specialty production. This would potentially result in Ontario giving up its discrete supply under the proposed amendments to the Operating Agreement, while increasing its domestic production by 500,000 kg.

As this proposal has direct ramifications on the proposed amendments which are the subject of this Review, and as this proposal was apparently brought forward without any consultation with the processing sector in BC, the BC processors ask that all background information, proposals, notes of discussions, memos and any other material relevant to this proposal, including the perspective of the BC Board on this proposal, be forwarded immediately to me for distribution to the BC processors.

At this point, given the lack of information we have been provided, we cannot say whether further submissions will be required on this issue.
