**QUOTA ASSESSMENT REVIEW – TIMELINE UPDATE**

Further to my letter of November 24, 2017 (attached), I am writing to provide a further update on the BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) quota review on behalf of the BCFIRB supervisory panel carrying out the review. The panel consists of John Les (Chair), Diane Pastoor, Al Sakalauskas, Daphne Stancil, Corey Van't Haaff and Chris Wendell. While Mr. Wendell's appointment to BCFIRB expired on December 31, 2017, Mr. Wendell has been retained per authority under the *Administrative Tribunals Act (BC)* as a panel member on this review until it is complete.

As you know, the BCFIRB panel has been actively working to determine what changes may be needed to BCFIRB's current quota management policies and directions to continue to support industry growth. Please be assured that the conclusion of this review and the issuance of a decision remains a top priority for the panel.
