EXPANDING LIST OF EXEMPT PERSONS – SUBMISSION EXTENSIONS

In an August 3, 2018 letter, the BC Egg Marketing Board (Egg Board) requested that the BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) make a change to its February 2, 2018 Quota Assessment Tools Supervisory Review directions (Quota Review).

Specifically the Egg Board recommended that the persons listed in Part V of the Egg Board's Consolidated Orders be added to those exempt from the quota transfer-related 12 month moratorium on receiving growth.

BCFIRB asked for further information from the Egg Board by November 7, 2018¹ for consideration at its November board meeting. BCFIRB also requested input from the other supply-managed commodity boards by November 9, 2018².

On October 30, 2018 the Egg Board requested a submission extension to December 5, 2018. BCFIRB verbally approved the requested extension on October 30, 2018. This letter confirms the extension granted.
