Hello All,

The BCFIRB Chicken Sector Pricing Review panel was notified late Friday January 14, that the BC Chicken Marketing Board (Chicken Board) will be asking BCFIRB to prior approve a change to the interim chicken pricing formula by this coming Friday, January 21.

In the interest of forming an initial response to this request from the Chicken Board, the BCFIRB panel is asking that once you review the Chicken Board's A-174 pricing decision expected on January 19, 2022, that you please:

- provide the BCFIRB Chicken Sector Pricing Review panel with a short "position statement" (e.g., 1-2 pages), summarizing your overall views on the Chicken Board's decision, and whether or not you would support prior approval of the change by BCFIRB. This short document is requested by the end of day January 20, 2022.

Once the panel has an opportunity to review your organization's brief "position statement" on this matter, the panel will then determine and communicate what, if any, next steps are required with respect to a prior approval of this requested change from the Chicken Board.
