
We write further to our submission of July 19, 2021 with respect to the proposed panel for the interim orders. In the second to last paragraph of that letter, we advised that the potatoes planted by Prokam would be ready for harvest and sale “in a few weeks”. We are now able to provide further specificity as to the anticipated timing of harvest of these potatoes. We are instructed that the potatoes are anticipated to be ready for harvest in late September or early October.

At present, although the potatoes were planted on notice to the Commission and pursuant to Prokam’s delivery allocation, Prokam remains without an agency or a producer-shipper license to provide access to the market at this time.
