The Canada-B.C. Official Languages Agreement on French Services supports the development and delivery of French services for British Columbia's Francophone community. This Agreement is set to expire on March 31, 2018. In preparation for negotiations with the federal government, I am leading a public engagement process aimed at gathering your thoughts and ideas on how the provincial government can improve access to programs and services in French.

I am asking Francophone organisations, and other interested groups and individuals throughout British Columbia to discuss their needs and priorities to help us explore the development of new approaches to enhancing services in French in British Columbia

Written submissions will be accepted until January 12th, 2018. Shortly thereafter, a report summarizing feedback will be publicly released and shared with you. The report will include results of the feedback and will identify potential opportunities. This information will also be used to develop a multi-year Strategic Plan, which will be an integral part of the new Cooperation Agreement with the federal government.

All feedback is welcome and an invitation to submit is not required.
