Family with dependent children, family unit size = 2 persons	*\$150	\$570
Family with dependent children, family unit size = 3 persons	*\$200	\$665
Family with dependent children, family unit size = 4 persons	*\$225	\$715
Family with dependent children, family unit size = 5 persons	*\$250	\$765
Family with dependent children, family unit size = 6 persons	*\$275	\$815
Family with dependent children, family unit size = 7 persons	*\$300	\$865

### **Notes:**

- All rates are monthly.
- In addition to the support allowance, families may also receive a monthly payment for each child under 19 years of age. For more information, see [Child Benefits Top-up Supplement](#).
- \*If actual shelter costs are less than the minimum shelter allowance, the minimum shelter allowance will be provided.
- \*Minimum shelter allowance increments continue to increase by an additional \$25 for each additional dependant after unit size 7.
- Maximum shelter allowance increments continue to increase by an additional \$50 for each additional dependant after unit size 7.
