

# Senior's Supplement Rate Table

Effective: July 1, 2021

The following table shows how to calculate the Senior's Supplement (SS) based on July 1, 2021 federal Old Age Security (OAS)/Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)/Allowance payment levels.
