As you are a recipient of Income Assistance and are applying for a Persons with Disabilities (PWD) designation, you may also be eligible for Canada Pension Plan Disability (CPPD) benefits from the federal government.

CPPD benefits may provide you with:

- Higher Canada Pension Plan (CPP) retirement benefits
- A higher income than PWD assistance
- The option to receive these benefits anywhere in Canada

Please note that to apply for CPPD benefits you may need:

- Your Social Insurance Number
- Birth certificate for you and any children you have
- List of work history including start and end dates, names of employers, country where employed and any work permit details
- All claim numbers, dates, and amounts for any accident, illness, or disability benefits from any insurance company, including Employment Insurance (EI) and WorkSafe BC, where applicable

- Medical history for the past two years including name, address, and phone number of family physicians, other physicians seen, hospitalizations, and any prescribed medications
