Deepfake: A form of AI that creates convincing fake audio, images and video to represent someone doing or saying something that they did not actually do. Cybercriminals can use this technique to trick victims into thinking someone they know is telling them something urgent, like a grandson (deepfake) telling their grandparent (victim) they need money get out of jail.
