Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team is aware Cisco has published a bulletin to address these vulnerabilities.

Technical Details

On September 28, 2023, Mozilla published a security advisory to address vulnerabilities in the following products:

- Firefox 118.0.1
- Firefox ESR 115.3.1
- Firefox Focus for Android 118.1
- Firefox for Android 118.1

Specific handling of an attacker-controlled VP8 media stream could lead to a heap buffer overflow in the content process. We are aware of this issue being exploited in other products in the wild.

This vulnerability is rated as a **Critical** Severity.

Recommended Action

- Investigate how your area of responsibility is affected.
- Notify business owner(s) as required.
- *Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.*
