The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team is aware Google has published a security advisory, to address vulnerabilities in Chrome for Desktop.

- Chrome for Desktop Stable Channel – versions prior to 118.0.5993.117 (Mac and Linux) and 118.0.5993.117/.118 (Windows)
- Chrome for Desktop Extended Stable Channel – versions prior to 118.0.5993.117 (Mac and Linux) and 118.0.5993.118 (Windows)

Technical Details

The Stable channel has been updated to 118.0.5993.117 for Mac and Linux and 118.0.5993.117/.118 for Windows, which will roll out over the coming days/weeks. A full list of changes in this build is available in the [log](#).

These vulnerabilities are rated as an overall **High** Severity.

Recommended Action

- Investigate how your area of responsibility is affected.
- Notify business owner(s) as required.
- *Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.*
