## Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team is aware IBM has published a Security Bulletin to address Multiple products. Included were critical updates for the following:

- Platform Navigator in IBM Cloud Pak for Integration (CP4I) – multiple versions
- Automation Assets in IBM Cloud Pak for Integration (CP4I) – multiple versions
- IBM Storage Ceph – version 5.3z1-z4 and versions prior to 6.1

## Technical Details

Golang Go could allow a remote attacker to execute arbitrary code on the system, caused by a flaw in the go.mod toolchain directive. By sending a specially crafted request, an attacker could exploit this vulnerability to execute arbitrary code on the system.

CVSS Base score: 9.8

This vulnerability is rated as a **Critical** Severity.

## Recommended Action

- Investigate how your area of responsibility is affected.
- Notify business owner(s) as required.
- *Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.*
