### Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team is aware VMware has published a security advisory to address vulnerabilities in the following product:

- Network Configuration Manager – version 2023.3.1 and prior

### Technical Details

The Network Configuration Manager was susceptible to a Directory Traversal Remote Code Execution Vulnerability. This vulnerability allows a low-level user to perform the actions with SYSTEM privileges.

These vulnerabilities are rated as an overall **High** Severity.

### Recommended Action

- Investigate how your area of responsibility is affected.
- Notify business owner(s) as required.
- *Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.*
