Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team is aware that Ubuntu published security notices to address vulnerabilities in the Linux kernel affecting the following products:

- Ubuntu 18.04 ESM
- Ubuntu 20.04 LTS
- Ubuntu 22.04 LTS
- Ubuntu 23.04

Technical Details

Florian Picca discovered that strongSwan incorrectly handled certain DH public values. A remote attacker could use this issue to cause strongSwan to crash, resulting in a denial of service, or possibly execute arbitrary code.

These vulnerabilities are rated as an overall **Critical** Severity.

Recommended Action

- Investigate how your area of responsibility is affected.
- Notify business owner(s) as required.
- *Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.*
