## Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team has been made aware Ubuntu published security notices to address vulnerabilities in the Linux kernel affecting the following products:

- Ubuntu 20.04 LTS
- Ubuntu 22.04 LTS

## Technical Details

An issue in NPM IP Package v.1.1.8 and before allows an attacker to execute arbitrary code and obtain sensitive information via the isPublic() function.

### **Exploitability Metrics**

Attack Vector: Network  
Attack Complexity: Low  
Privileges Required: None  
User Interaction: None

This vulnerability is rated as a **CRITICAL** risk. A software update exists to address these risks.

## Action Required

- Locate the device or application and investigate.
- Notify business owner(s).
- Perform mitigating actions, as required.
