Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team is aware of Red Hat published security advisories to address vulnerabilities in multiple products. Included were updates to address vulnerabilities in the Linux kernel for the following products:

- Red Hat CodeReady Linux Builder – multiple versions and platforms
- Red Hat Enterprise Linux – multiple versions and platforms
- Red Hat Enterprise Linux Server – multiple versions and platforms
- Red Hat Enterprise Linux for Real Time – multiple versions and platforms

Technical Details

Vulnerability in core of Apache HTTP Server 2.4.59 and earlier are vulnerably to information disclosure, SSRF or local script execution via backend applications whose response headers are malicious or exploitable. Users are recommended to upgrade to version 2.4.60, which fixes this issue.

This vulnerability is rated as a **CRITICAL** risk. Software updates exist to address these risks.

Action Required

- Locate the device or application and investigate.
- Notify business owner(s).
- Perform mitigating actions, as required.
