### Summary

The Vulnerability and Risk Management (VRM) Team has been made aware Google published a security advisory to address vulnerabilities in the following products:

- Stable Channel Chrome for Desktop – versions prior to 128.0.6613.137/.138 (Windows and Mac) and 128.0.6613.137 (Linux)

### Technical Details

The Stable channel has been updated to 128.0.6613.137/.138 for Windows, Mac and 128.0.6613.137 for Linux which will roll out over the coming days/weeks. A full list of changes in this build is available in the [Log](#).

This vulnerability is rated as a **HIGH** risk. A software update exists to address this risk.

### Action Required

- Locate the device or application and investigate.
- Notify business owner(s).
- Perform mitigating actions, as required.
