## CONDITIONS

- 1. The access and use of any system, radio or frequency shall not impair the operational use of the system or frequency by the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development. Improper use may result in the termination of access and the user shall be held liable for any injury and/or damages.
- 2. No additional costs shall be incurred by, or accrue to, the Ministry through such authorized access.
- 3. This Ministry bears no responsibility to provide:
  - continuity of service;
  - extension of radio coverage into areas not presently served;
  - continuous monitoring of frequency(ies), or check-in system;
  - radio equipment, training or technical assistance or advice.
- 4. The user covenants and agrees to release the Province from any and all claims, demands, actions and damages arising from or out of any act or omission on the part of the Province or its employees, contractors or agents in the exercise, or purported exercise, of the rights conferred by this agreement.
- In the event an application is not approved, the applicant shall be entitled to a review of the application by the Ministry. To initiate a review please write to Manager of Radio Operations, Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development, 343-B Bay St., Victoria BC V8T 1P5.
- 6. All users shall comply with all appropriate Industry Canada requirements. These regulations are available from any office of Industry Canada.
- 7. Any user of the Ministry radio system shall adhere to the Ministry's Radio System Operating Rules attached to the Letter of Authorization, which will be issued upon approval of the request for access. All users must possess the knowledge and skills required by Industry Canada. Applicants and users will be held liable for damage or injury caused by non-compliance.
- 8. Authorization of access will be based on the user's operational requirements, and may be restricted to locations required under this agreement.
- 9. All Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development frequencies shall be removed from radios upon termination of access, and proof of the removal shall be supplied upon request.
- 10. Access may only be granted to Air Carriers approved by the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development Protection Branch, Air Operations Section.
- 11. The user shall indemnify and save harmless the Province, its employees and agents from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses that the Province may sustain, incur, suffer or be put to at any time either before or after the expiration or termination of this agreement, where the same or any of them are based upon, arise out of or occur, directly or indirectly, by reason of any act or omission of the user or of any agent, employee, officer or director of the user pursuant to this agreement.
- 12. The maximum period for a Letter of Authority shall be 5 years unless otherwise authorized by Radio Operations, Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development.
