The GWI is applied as the cents per hour equivalent to the percent of pay which would be paid from the ESD formula. ESD formula = .45%. The cents per hour equivalent is \$.1301. This amount is applied to all wage rates.

01 Aug 1981	8.00%	An increase of eight (8) percent to salary rates in the bargaining unit.
01 Aug 1980	8.00%	An increase of eight (8) percent to salary rates in the bargaining unit.
01 Aug 1979	8.00%	An increase of eight (8) percent with a minimum of \$80.00 and a maximum of \$159.00 per month to salary rates in the bargaining unit. Teachers received \$191.00.
