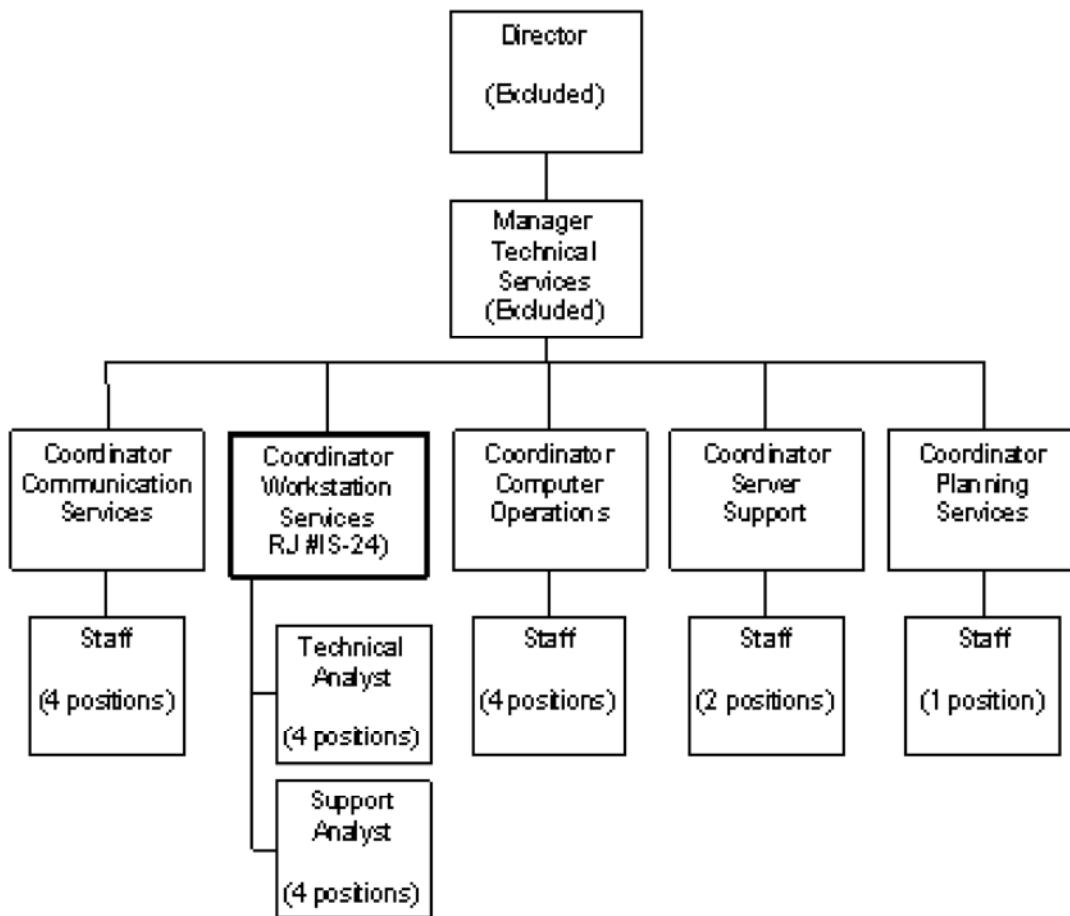
PRIMARY FUNCTION

To coordinate technical support, configuration, installation and integration services for all multiple desktop computing platforms in the ministry, including hardware, operating systems and communications interfaces.

JOB DUTIES AND TASKS

1. Coordinates technical support for the Ministry's multiple desktop computer platforms including hardware, operating systems and communication interfaces such as (Intel, Disc architecture, DOS and Windows)
 - a. ensures support resources are being applied effectively
 - b. establishes and determines support requirements and service levels for specific products and/or technology
 - c. troubleshoots problems and supports various groups in resolving chronic network problems which originate at the desktop
 - d. coordinates and follows up on problem resolution for desktop problems escalated by group and/or help desk staff
2. Coordinates and plans provision of services for configuration, installation and integration
 - a. coordinates and plans installation, redeployment and integration of all desktop hardware, operating systems and communications components for the Ministry
 - b. coordinates and initiates the claim process for all computer equipment under warranty
 - c. prioritizes resources and schedules over 100 work orders, which may affect up to 200 installations per work order
 - d. conducts field office visits to oversee and/or provide technical support or planned installations
3. Leads and provides technical consultation on issues related to the ministry's desktop platforms
 - a. coordinates purchasing configuration decisions, platform migration plans and the selection of desktop communications options
 - b. provides advice to senior management on the deployment of new desktop technologies, products and services for all ministry locations
 - c. leads the identification and resolution of integration issues with existing operational environment including evaluating alternatives
 - d. coordinates the development of ministry standards for chosen computing platforms and products including hardware/software configuration/integration standards
4. Supervises staff and contractors
 - a. supervises recruits and trains 8 FTE technical and support analyst staff
 - b. plans, schedules, assigns and reviews work

- c. sets work priorities and standards
 - d. conducts formal appraisals of work performance
5. Performs other related duties
- a. coordinates the development and maintenance of support documentation for internal/external use
 - b. arranges purchase of desktop platforms and peripherals
 - c. provides contract administration, verifies technical requirements and certifies satisfactory contract performance
 - d. provides input into contract resources required, monitors and certifies work of contractors
 - e. verifies technical requirements for all contracts impacting desktop computing platforms
