ACCW houses sentenced and remanded female offenders in a rural setting that offers plenty of active outdoor work. Your leadership, problem-solving and communication skills will complement our training to assist you in providing effective direct supervision to inmates. You will also have the opportunity to deliver evidence based programs proven to reduce re offending and help inmates develop lifelong skills.

### Types of staff positions:

- » **Living Unit:** supervises and provides case management for inmates in secure units and dorm-like residences
- » **Programs:** program delivery, supervision of program areas and activities
- » **Work Programs:** supervises maintenance, laundry, horticulture
- » **Horticulture Instructor:** supervises greenhouse and garden programs
- » **Security and control:** controls access into and within the centre
- » **Sentence management:** records entry, admission and discharge of inmates

### Features:

- » Located in a beautiful, natural outdoor setting
- » Fully equipped staff fitness facility, staff lounge and outdoor patio
- » Lots of free parking
- » Active social and wellness committee for staff
- » On-site doggy day care

### Quick facts:

- » The facility provides safe and secure custody for open (community suitable) medium and secure classified offenders
- » ACCW houses up to 321 (166–secure, 134–medium and 24–open)
- » Inmates include those sentenced less than two years, or those on remand or immigration detainees
- » Staff complement: comprised of approximately 130 full and part-time employees
- » We recruit only female applicants for correctional officer positions

## Basic employee requirements — you:

- » have a strong sense of integrity and excellent communication skills
- » are 19 years or older
- » are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- » possess a valid B.C. class 5 driver's licence
- » have Grade 12 or equivalent

## Steps of the employment application process:

1. Online application: fill out and submit an online application and recruitment questionnaire
2. Interview: if suitable, you will be contacted to schedule an interview
3. Screenings: participate in a set of screenings, including physical abilities (COPAT), language proficiency (LPI), computer voice stress analysis (CVSA), vision and medical tests
4. Background checks: include references, credit checks and a criminal record search
5. First aid: have or obtain valid first aid (OFA) certification
