Situated in the centre of the province, Prince George Regional Correctional Centre (PGRCC) covers a vast territory; from Williams Lake to the Yukon border, from the Queen Charlottes to McBride. Your communications and people skills will complement our training to assist you in providing direct supervision of our clientele. Become part of a team that strives to protect our communities and reduce re-offending.

Types of staff positions:

- » **Living Unit:** monitors inmates in units comprised of common areas and housing cells
- » **Records:** supervises the admission or discharge of inmates
- » **Control:** responds to the operational requirements of the centre
- » **Programs:** supervises/facilitates work and inmate programs
- » **Visits:** supervises inmates and their visitors

Features:

- » Staff fitness facility, staff lounge and BBQ patio
- » Active social and wellness committees for staff
- » Shift patterns offer exceptional time off
- » A separate wing houses up to 42 female offenders

Quick facts:

- » PGRCC provides safe and secure custody for low, medium and high-risk offenders
- » Our 24/7 operation creates a variety of shift patterns year round
- » The centre houses approximately 300 inmates
- » Our inmate population consists of both male and female offenders on sentences of less than two years, on remand status or those who are immigration detainees
- » Staff complement: 149 full and part-time officers
- » We recruit both men and women officers

Basic employee requirements — you:

- » have a strong sense of integrity and excellent communication skills
- » are 19 years or older
- » are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- » possess a valid B.C. class 5 driver's licence
- » have Grade 12 or equivalent

Steps of the employment application process:

1. Online application: fill out and submit an online application and recruitment questionnaire
2. Interview: if suitable, you will be contacted to schedule an interview
3. Screenings: participate in a set of screenings, including physical abilities (COPAT), language proficiency (LPI), computer voice stress analysis (CVSA), vision and medical tests
4. Background checks: include references, credit checks and a criminal record search
5. First aid: have or obtain valid first aid (OFA) certification
