Instructions for applying for a Driver Improvement Program Review:

The review process is available only to prohibitions issued by the Superintendent of Motor Vehicles under section 93 of the Motor Vehicle Act.
Clients seeking a review must send a written submission along with the completed Application for Review form and pay a non-refundable fee of \$100 for each application.
The \$100 Review fee can be paid in person at a Driver Licensing Office. To find an office near you, visit icbc.com or look in the phone book under ICBC.
The \$100 Review fee can also be paid by certified cheque or money order, payable to the Minister of Finance.

Your written submission must:
• Provide reasons why the prohibition should not be imposed or should be for a shorter term
• Include any relevant supporting documentation
One submission is permitted for each application. Therefore you should ensure that your submission contains all the information you want to be considered.
Drivers who have received a final Notice of Prohibition or who have signed and dated a Notice of Intent to Prohibit are not eligible to drive.
